Summer freeboard in tropical seas 1 ft. 10 in = 559 mm below the upper edge of the statutory deck line

Summer freeboard (centre of disc) 2 ft. 1 in = 635 mm below the upper edge of the statutory deck line

Winter freeboard 2 ft. 4½ in = 724 mm below the upper edge of the statutory deck line

Winter freeboard in north Atlantic 2 ft. 7½ in = 800 mm below the upper edge of the statutory deck line.

The statutory deck line is to be marked in accordance with *the British*

Board of Trade Regulations 1½" = 38 mm

above the steel deck at side amidships.

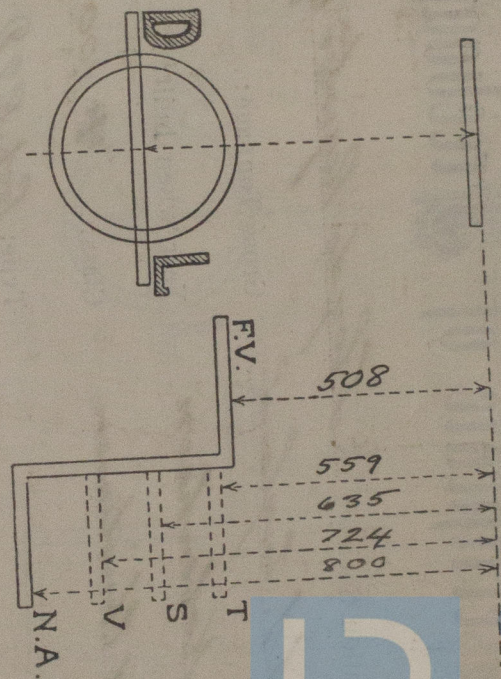
