

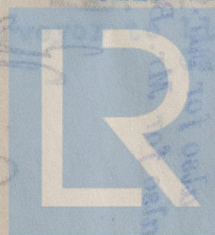
Dear Sir,

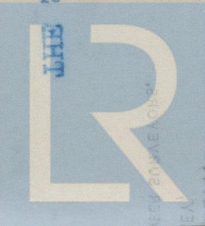
