With reference to Freeboard Verification forwarded herewith, we have to inform you that the following requirements have been carried out.

- (1) Air pipes have been fitted with canvas covers.
- (2) A Manilla lifeline is fitted across Nos. 1 & 2 hatches in the fore well.
- (3) Two freeing ports each 3'-3" x 18" have been cut on each side of the Raised Quarter Deck, giving a total area of 24.76 square feet. The distance from bridge end to these ports is 31'-6" and 49'-0" respectively.

The Timber Assignment is not required.

The Certificates are required by return of post.
