With reference to the freeboard assignment letters sent to you yesterday for the S.S. "BURNHOPE" giving the freeboards from the upper deck, I have to point out that the statutory deck line should be marked at $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches above the iron raised quarter deck side, in order that the corresponding freeboard of 7 ft. 2 inches from that deck may be entered on the certificate as in the case of the previous sister vessels.
