With reference to your letter of the 20th instant respecting the steamer "ABBOTSFORD", I beg to acquaint you that this vessel was last seen in drydock by the Society's Surveyors at Grangemouth in August 1939, when her class was continued without special restriction whatever in the Register Book.

She subsequently came under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle in October on account of damage caused by collision. Partial and temporary repairs were effected and her class was continued subject to permanent repairs to Shell Plates No. 4 in sheerstrake, No. 4 in 1st and No. 3 in 2nd below sheer on the starboard side after and framing, etc. in way being effected at the first opportunity.

The vessel would not have become due for her 2nd Special Survey No. 1 or for her Tailshaft inspection until April, 1941 and August 1942 respectively, but the Boiler Survey became due at the end of April last.
