

# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

Dear Sir,

We have a letter from Messrs.Cie.Marchande Export-Import stating that they have sold the S/S"LE PHOQUE" No.78224 in the Register Book for breaking up. We also learn that she has been taken to Bruges for that purpose and that the purchasers are however waiting instructions from their Ghent office before the work of demolition is commenced.

With regard to the fees to be charged in this case we are sending out on account in accordance with our usual scale but increasing the hull fee by £ 12 to cover the probable expenses of Mr.Butler when he visited the vessel here on the 20th and 21st January 1939 which I trust will be in order.

The total fees being Hull £ 40, Machinery £ 12 (at par) plus Frs.494 expenses.

I hasten to give you this information as I understand the claim on the underwriters has not yet been settled and I feel our fees may become a bad debt for us.
