Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 4236 dated 13th July 1934, I have to inform you that I have been advised by the Lloyd's Classification Committee to make quite clear to you that in the event of the vessel leaving the port without the 2nd Special Survey No. 2 being carried out her class would have to be expunged at once from the Register Book.

I may, however, add that the only condition on which the Committee upto the present have agreed to the vessel's class being maintained whilst laid up, is that all overdue surveys would be attended to before the vessel proceeds to sea or is placed in commission.
