With reference to your letter 'M.' dated 15-1-14.  
The Karachi Port Trust have requested me to complete  
the Survey of re-erection of the steel non-propelling  
dredger No 773, built by Messrs Lubitz & Co & shipped  
in pieces to this Port. The work is being carried out  
under the Supervision of one of the Masters representative  
and progressing fast and very favourably. The work  
of laying the plates on slip-way was commenced on the  
24<sup>th</sup> of March about 3 weeks ago and so far all the  
bottom plates, girders, beams, bulkheads, boiler seatings,  
bow & stern plates, ~~and~~ are being rivetted together now,  
this will be the largest launch at this Port, and looks  
quite an imposing sight on the Slip, photos are taken  
every week to show the work in progress for the R. P. T.  
Board, and I hope to send you one before the sides  
are rivetted on if you would care to have one.


