It is submitted the Karachi Surveyor be informed that this vessel is to be shipped in pieces to his port, and that it is to be re-erected at his port.

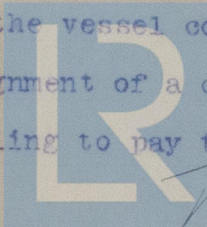
He should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to forward a report on Form 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
