Messrs. John & Co. Ltd. Refractory, survey the steel
framing of the new dredger (Yard No 778)
220' x 46' x 18' tall. white building at their works
at Refractory on 29 May 1913 & subsequent dates.
This vessel is for the Karachi Port Trust, and
has been formed, and keelson, stringers, bulkheads,
beams, deck stringers and plating, shell plating,
pillars & deck girder erected in position, but
practically no riveting done excepting in floors,
beams & reverse frames. The anchors, wires,
& transverse winches, Capstan, 3 Beege
portable hand pumps have been supplied
and fitted in position.

As far as advanced, the vessel has been constructed
to my entire satisfaction, and in accordance
with plans approved for the class "A" - "Dredger".
