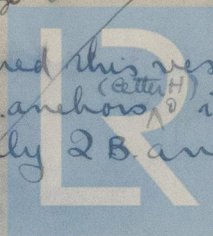
It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 2.39 as recommended.
