Dear Sir,

With reference to London letter dated the 4<sup>th</sup> inst regarding the S/S Wheatsheaf I beg to state that there are no liners on the screw shaft, a Cedervall gland being fitted.

The donkey boiler is fitted with one spring loaded safety valve 2½" dia, 4.9" area, and is adjusted to 105 lb<sup>o</sup>, and fitted with lasing gear; steam cannot enter from the main to the donkey boiler, which is placed in the stokehold.
