I beg to acquaint you that the steamer "CHARLBURY" has been examined by the Society's Surveyors at Barry, and it would appear that in order to comply with the requirements of the International Loadline Convention the following will require to be done:-

1. Hatchway beam on No.3 hatchway on superstructure deck should be made equal to the requirements of the Rules.
2. The covers of the escape hatchways in the tween decks in way of No.3 hatchway should be secured to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

I may add that particulars of the Freeboards which could be assigned under the Convention will be forwarded to you immediately on receipt of information regarding the displacement, which is being obtained from the Builders.
