In reply to enquiry the Newport Surveyor states that the vessel has been purchased by Messrs. John Cashmore & Sons of his port, for breaking up, and the work of demolition will commence in about two months time.

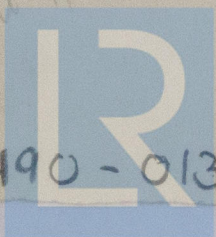
It is submitted the vessel be ~~Posted~~ as "To be broken up" in the Register Book.
