Dear Sir,

With reference to the Third Special Survey No. 2 which became due at the end of November last on the steamer "ATLANTEN", I have to acquaint you the Committee have had before them a request from the Owners to postpone this inspection until about the 10/15th January, 1936, when they propose to have the same carried out at Solvesborg. The Committee have agreed to this request on the understanding that definite arrangements will be made to carry out the survey at the time stated without fail in view of the fact that the year of grace for the completion of the survey will expire at the end of next month.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention in due course.

I think it well to add that the vessel's class is subject to some indented plating and damaged frames on the port and starboard sides being dealt with at the Owners convenience and the riveting of the tunnel stools requires to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.

You will observe that the Boiler Survey will become due at the end of the present month.
