Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of the 14th instant, having further reference to the case of your steamer "ATLANTEN", in which you request that the Third Special Survey No.2 may be postponed until the 10th to the 15th January.

The Committee have had this request before them at their meeting to-day, and I have the pleasure to say that in the circumstances referred to in your cablegram, they have agreed to this postponement, and the vessel's class will accordingly be maintained until January next, as desired.

The Committee trust that in view of the extension now granted definite arrangements will be made for the Third Special Survey No.2 to be carried out by the time stated without fail, having regard to the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of this survey will expire in November.

Perhaps you will be good enough to advise me in due course at what port the survey will be held.
