The Third Special Survey No.2 became due 11,34 and a proposal postpone same until November next has been agreed to.

The Owners on the 30th ultimo wrote to say that owing to a *requested postponement of* ~~they decided to postpone~~ the survey until April next, and referred to fact that the vessel was examined in dry dock in May last. They also mentioned the survey was not due until November of this year.

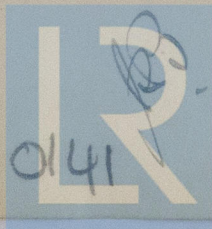
