Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, respecting your steamer "ATLANTEN", in which you request that the overdue Third Special Survey No.2 might be postponed until April of next year.

With regard to the statement in your letter that the survey is due in November this year, I beg to point out that you appear to be under a misapprehension in this respect. Actually the Third Special Survey No.2 became due in November, 1934, and the year of grace, which the Committee have allowed in this case for completion of the survey, will therefore expire at the end of next month.

In this connexion I would explain that the Special Periodical Surveys Nos.1, 2 and 3 become due at 4, 8 and 12 years from the previous recorded Special Survey No.3. In this case the Second Special Survey No.3 was held at Leith in November, 1926, and therefore, as stated above, the Third Special Survey No.2 became due in November, 1934.

In these circumstances the Committee regret that they do not see how they can, consistently with the Rules, agree to the postponement you desire, and they must ask you therefore to be good enough to arrange for the survey to be


