Dear Sirs,

F. I have to acquaint you that a Swedish Convention freeboard certificate was issued in June, 1933 to the steamer "ATLANTEN", No. 71910 in the Register Book, which vessel it is observed from the Shipping Papers is now at your port, but consequent upon her transfer to the Finnish Flag this certificate is no longer valid.

In reply to enquiry the Helsingfors Surveyor wrote early this month that the vessel was then on her way to Archangel from which port she would return to England where the freeboards could be verified in order that the appropriate Finnish certificate could be issued.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention and for your information and guidance I enclose a memorandum of the freeboards together with a marking diagram and have to add that the Timber Winter North Atlantic freeboard has been altered from 1568mm to 1531mm in accordance with the Finnish Regulations.

On receipt of your verification of marking form the certificates will be forwarded for issue.
