With reference to your letter of the 25th January last addressed to Mr. V.M. Linklater at Rouen, enclosing particulars taken from the previous freeboard report of the S/S "ATLANTEN", we have to state that the Rouen Surveyor informed us on the 16th instant that nothing had been done at that port, and that the vessel had left for Ghent. 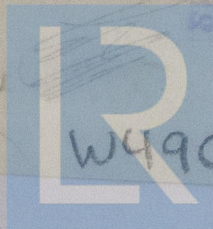
