With reference to the Special Survey No. 3, which became due at the end of September, 1931, on the steamer "MONTAUK", I have to acquaint you that following a report received from the Society's Surveyors at New York last month the Committee agreed to this vessel's class being maintained for a voyage to Italy where it was understood she would be broken up.

The vessel has been sold to Messrs.
