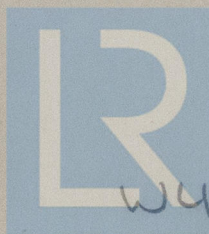
A footnote to this effect is being added to the list in this Office of vessels laid up under an undertaking.
