the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners survey the Steel Screw Steamer "MONTAUK" 7772 tons gross of Trieste as she lay afloat and on dry dock at Robins Dry Dock & Repair Co., Tebo Plant, Brooklyn, N. Y., on May 21st, 1935, and subsequently for the purpose of ascertaining the general condition of the vessel prior to proceeding to Italy for breaking up.

The bottom and rudder cleaned and examined and found good.

The tail shaft was drawn and examined and found good; the stern gland was repacked after replacing the shaft; the sea and overboard discharge valves were opened up and found or now placed in good order.

The decks, casings, holds, 'tween decks, tunnel, after peak tank, Nos. 3 and 4 double bottom tanks, port and starboard deep tanks, engine and boiler spaces, hatches, coamings, beams, hatch covers, tarpaulins and battening arrangements examined, water tight doors examined.

The steering gear examined under working conditions and found or now placed in good order.

The boilers were examined internally and externally and found in good condition, all mountings opened up and found or now placed in good order.

The safety valves were adjusted under steam to 210 lbs.

The main engines and auxiliaries examined under working conditions, the pumping arrangements examined and the pumps tried under working conditions.

The vessel is, in my opinion, fit to proceed on the contemplated voyage to Italy.
