Survey

The class is subject to the sole piece of the stern frame, repaired by electric welding 2,32 and 11,33, being specially examined at the next redocking.

The Falmouth Surveyors now report the ship placed in drydock after grounding, now damage found and the bottom cleaned and coated.


On account of damage through collision, 2 shell plates have been repaired and minor repairs carried out.

The sole piece of the sternframe has been examined and again repaired by electric welding.

It is submitted the ship appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 9,34 (Sternframe rewelded 9,34).
