Reverting to your letter of the 28th June last respecting your steamer "NASSA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, who have held a Modified Special Survey.

In view of the vessel's condition as now reported, the Committee have agreed to the vessel's class remaining undisturbed for a period of 6 months beyond the year of grace, namely until the end of January next.

The Surveyors also report that the Boiler Survey has been held at this time, and the Committee have accordingly assigned to the vessel a notation of B.S. 7,35.
