Dear Sirs,

A. I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr Larg's letter of the 12th instant, enclosing for signature the test certificates for the boilers built at your Port for the Oiler "NASSA". With regard thereto and to the remarks contained in the last paragraph of your letter I would point out that following the usual practice these certificates will be handed over with the Classification Certificates on payment of the fees, and as the fees for the survey of the hull and machinery of this vessel will be applied for from this Office on receipt of your first entry reports and the Certificates forwarded direct to the Admiralty from this Office, the test certificates forwarded by you will be retained here pending payment of the fees.

I may add that the test certificate for the main boiler built at Chatham Dockyard is also being retained in this Office, and will be forwarded with the other certificates in accordance with the above arrangement.
