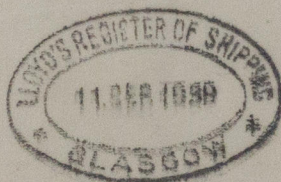
Sold to W.H. Arnott, Young & Co. Vessel arrived at Troon on the 26/8/39.
