B.</i></p>	<p>Date:— 24th December 1934</p> <p>The steamer was undocked on 4th December and is still afloat in the port of Algiers discharging wood cargo from after holds to another Greel steamer for shipment to Alexandria where the cargo has been sold.</p> <p>The present Owners intentions are unknown but it is expected she will be sold as she stands or taken to Genoa to be broken up.</p> <p>I am rather pleased with my elaborate cementing temporary repairs, built not one house but nearly two houses inside and beyond three small leaks at first now tight, she is practically dry.</p> <p>Delaying my report to learn the Owners intentions.</p> <p><i>Handwritten signature: S.B.</i></p>
