S. I am in receipt of your letters of yesterday's date respecting the cases of the Motorships "CHEYENNE" and "CAMROUX I", and in reply to the enquiries contained therein have to say it is considered a fee of £5.5.0 should be charged in the case of the former vessel in respect of the portion of the Continuous Survey of the Oil Engines held at this time.

With regard to the "CAMROUX I", I would say that it is considered no C.S. fee is chargeable now.

At the same time, it would appear that you are in error in your Report No.97110, in assuming that the auxiliary compressor, pumps, air receivers and auxiliary compressor engine were renewed when the new main engine was fitted in August 1937.

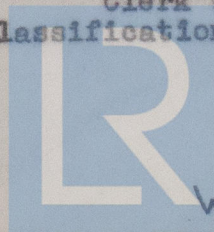
