Conditions of assignment complied with as follows:-

- (1) An additional tarpaulin provided for the coaling hatchways on the bridge deck, one tarpaulin provided for each hatchway on the free board deck in the bridge space and wood covers provided for the coaling hatchways in this space.
- (2) Efficient means of closing provided for all ventilators and air pipes.
- (3) Provision made for rigging lifelines in the wells for the use of the crew in the regular working of the ship.
- (4) The closing arrangements for the doors in the machinery casings on the bridge and freeboard decks made efficient.
