H. I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 18th instant relative to the steamer "GARDENGA", and have to acquaint you that the Committee have today had this case under their consideration in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 3rd Special Survey No.1 expired at the end of last month. As it would appear from your communication that the vessel is still laid up at your port, I shall be glad if you will explain to the Owners that it is the Committee's usual practice to require an undertaking to be furnished stating that all overdue surveys will be carried out before the vessel again goes into commission. The Committee conclude the Owners will have no objection to doing so in this instance, and I enclose a printed form of undertaking which I shall be glad if you will arrange to be signed and returned to this Office in due course.


A duplicate copy of the form is also enclosed for the Owners' filing purposes.
