I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

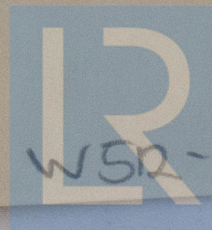

