### CONDITIONS.

1.—Either the Postmaster-General or any Telegraph Company or Foreign Government, by whom this Telegram is or would be in the ordinary course of the Telegraphic Service be forwarded, may decline to forward the Telegram although it has been received for that purpose; but in such case the amount paid for transmission shall be refunded to the sender at his request.

2.—Neither the Postmaster-General nor any Telegraph Company or Foreign Government, by whom this Telegram is or would be in the ordinary course of the Telegraphic Service be forwarded, shall be liable to make compensation for any loss, injury, or damage arising or resulting from non-transmission or non-delivery of the Telegram, or delay, or error, or omission in the transmission or delivery thereof, through whatever cause such non-transmission, non-delivery, delay, error, or omission shall have occurred.

3.—This Telegram shall be forwarded in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations made pursuant to the Telegraph Acts, and the provisions of such Regulations shall be deemed to be binding not only between the Sender and the Postmaster-General, but between the Sender and any Telegraph Company or Foreign Government by whom this Telegram is or would be in the ordinary course of the Telegraphic Service be forwarded.

§ The substance of these Regulations will be found in the Post Office Guide.

**NOTE.**—In Telegrams bearing addresses consisting of a name prefixed to a **REGISTERED ADDRESS** or addressed to one person at the house of another, whose name is also given, it is necessary to insert "chez" (which means "care of") or an equivalent expression in the language of the country of destination. It is undesirable to use the words "care," "care of," or the equivalent symbol "c/o," in the case of Telegrams addressed to other than English-speaking countries.
