As this is contrary to the Society's requirements, I shall be glad if you will confer with the Owners, with a view to the Rule requirements being complied with.

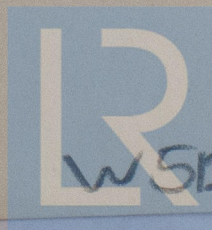
