This case is stated in the endorsements dated the 3rd and 16th September last.

The Gibraltar Surveyor wrote on the 9th November last that he was only waiting to see a turn out of the engines after some small repairs had been effected, before issuing a certificate.

The Surveyor was of the opinion that if funds had not run out, the vessel would have proceeded satisfactorily on her voyage.

In a further letter dated the 21st December, the Gibraltar Surveyor wrote that the Owner was then convinced that the vessel was unsuitable for the intended service.

The attached letter has now been received from Commander Wardrop, Master and part Owner of the vessel.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
