I am in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant regarding the T.S.S. "GARDENGA", and I note that you now desire that the draught may be increased to 6'-9".

With regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that the plans have again been examined, and it is found that for the restricted service proposed the scantlings and arrangements are such as could be approved for the increased draught desired, provided there are no openings in the lower deck aft and ample freeing ports are provided.

With reference to the last paragraph of your letter, I have pleasure in enclosing a letter giving the moulded dimensions, draught and class of the vessel.

It is not possible to state the ballast draught, as this must vary with the amount of ballast carried.
