With reference to your letter M. of the 6th September regarding the Freeboard of the above vessel, we herewith enclose the C.II Report as requested.

This vessel is due to return to Genoa early in November, when it is anticipated the new Freeboards can be assigned. As stated in the Report, the air pipes from the fresh water & ballast tanks have no means of closing but it has been arranged to have canvas covers fitted and to be ready for examination on the vessel's return. The air pipes from the oil fuel tanks have each a gauze fitted.
