E. I return herewith the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 19th instant, of superheaters proposed to be made by The Superheater Co. Ltd. for Messrs. John Dickinson & Sons, Ltd., (S.S. "CAITHNESS"), and have to say that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 180 lb. per square inch, provided the steel castings be made at Approved Works, and tested as required by the Rules, a safety valve be fitted to each part of the superheaters which can be isolated from the boilers, and the superheaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the whole be tested to three times the working pressure.

One set of the plans forwarded is being retained for reference in this Office.
