I have to report that I have surveyed the

SS DAWSON "EX" CAITHNESS of *Newcastle* O.N. *142711*

on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Vessel examined in dry dock, and 2nd special survey NO 1-35 now completed. at Blyth - record of survey 10, 35. The name of this vessel has now been changed the port of Registry, Newcastle-on-Tyne. Note. a tonnage opening 4'-2" x 3'-6", sill 15" high is fitted at the Bridge after bulkhead (port side) giving access to the bridge space. This opening is fitted with riveted channels & stow boards full height. 49 defective hatch covers renewed.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. *916* dated *18th June 1932.* which is returned herewith.
