I have to report that I have surveyed the

MSD DAWSON "EX" CAITHNESS of Newcastle O.N. 142411

on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Vessel examined in dry dock, and 2nd special survey NO 1-35 now completed. at Blyth - record of survey 10, 35. The name of this vessel has now been changed the port of Registry, Newcastle-on-Tyne. Note. a tonnage opening 4'-2" x 3'-6" sill 15" high is fitted at the Bridge after bulkhead (port side) giving access to the bridge space. This opening is fitted with riveted channels & stow boards full height. 49 defective hatch covers renewed.


The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 916 dated 18th June 1932. which is returned herewith.
