The old freeboard certificates, forwarded with the letter in question, have been retained in this Office for collation.

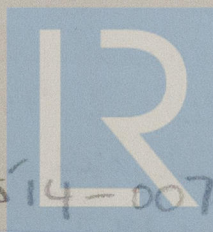
