"NAUSICAA", I beg to state that the spacing of the rivets in the edges of the outside plating in way of the oil tanks is 3 inches centre to centre as required by the Rules and the thickness of the double butt straps of the keel plate is .58" and .64". I regret this item was omitted from the report.
