We have considered your letter of 10th instant, with reference  
to the question of corrosion of steel used in shipbuilding.

It is the owners of the S.S. NAUSICAA, and not the builders,  
who are concerned with this question. Their ship is classed 100 A.1.  
at Lloyds, and your Society stands we think for the protection of  
shipowners, shippers and underwriters. Is not the Society  
specially and rightly interested in the chemical as well as the  
physical quality of the most important material used in the  
construction of the ships which they survey and class? It will  
be agreed that the chemical composition of the steel may or must  
affect its strength, durability and reliability, and for the  
Committee to take an interest in investigating the question of the  
chemical quality of shipbuilding steel would not we think be going  
out of their way, and would scarcely be even a new precedent.
