M. I have to return herewith Mr. Kendall's First Entry Report on the steel screw steamer "SAN FRANCISCO" built by Messrs. The North of Ireland Shipbuilding Co. (Yard No. 57) together with the approved sketches of midship section, pillars and girders and bulkheads, and I have to request that Mr. Kendall will be so good as to state whether the second deck beams are 10" x 3½" x 3½" x .54" as shown on the girder plan, and also whether the deep tank bulkheads are .4" in thickness. He should also make the thicknesses of E strake given on the sketch of midship section agree with those given in the report.
