I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 15th instant enclosing a plan shewing watertight cover for forward cargo hatch of the s.s. "SAN LEON", and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to state that the proposal will be approved, provided the steel cover can be efficiently riveted to the zed bar, the projecting flange of the zed bar be removed, and the zed bar be riveted watertight to the coaming.

The plan is returned herewith, and, as desired, I have telegraphed you today as follows :-

"SAN LEON PLAN APPROVED PROVIDED STEEL COVER CAN BE  
"EFFICIENTLY RIVETED TO ZED BAR THE PROJECTING FLANGE  
"OF ZED BAR BE REMOVED AND ZED BAR RIVETED WATERTIGHT  
"TO COAMING".
