I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 15th instant enclosing a plan shewing watertight cover for forward cargo hatch of the s.s. "SAN LEON", and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to state that the proposal will be approved, provided the steel cover can be efficiently riveted to the red bar, the projecting flange of the red bar be removed, and the red bar be riveted watertight to the coaming.

The plan is returned herewith, and, as desired, I have telegraphed you today as follows :-

"SAN LEON PLAN APPROVED PROVIDED STEEL COVER CAN BE
"EFFICIENTLY RIVETED TO RED BAR THE PROJECTING FLANGE
"OF RED BAR BE REMOVED AND RED BAR RIVETED WATERTIGHT
"TO COAMING".
