H. With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No. 1, which became due at the end of December last on the steamer "OTIRA", I have to acquaint you that the Committee recently agreed to this vessel proceeding on a voyage to the River Plate and thereafter to Italy to be broken up, provided the vessel were generally examined and found satisfactory and on the understanding that the voyage be completed by or before the end of February, 1937.

This examination has been carried out by the Glasgow and Barry Surveyors with satisfactory results and an interim certificate has been issued.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will keep this case in mind and advise me promptly when the work of demolition is commenced.


