Dear Sir,

I have to confirm my telephone message this afternoon regarding the case of the steamer "OTIRA", and to say that while the Committee will have no objection to the Interim Certificate now being issued embodying the final voyage to Italy with a non-perishable cargo from the United Kingdom or Continent, they consider some limiting period should be mentioned for the completion of this voyage.

It was previously anticipated that she would return from her River Plate voyage some time in January, and they have accordingly extended this period until the end of February to cover the subsequent voyage to her breaking up port.

I should add that on completion of the Annual Survey, the Freeboard Certificate and copy should be extended for a like period.
