Dear Sir:-

With reference to your letter of the 5th inst., regarding our Report No. 18, of the Survey of the Motor Vessel "ADA", we have to inform you that the thickness of "D" and "E" strakes of plates are as shown of the approved plans.

The thickness of "D" strake being 21.1# at midships, 21.1# aft, 24.1# forward, and of "E" strake 21.9# at midships, 21.9# <sup>aft</sup> forward, 24.1# <sup>forward</sup>. The increased thickness forward being for protection against ice.

The hatchend pillars and the stiffening to middle line bulkhead were fitted as shown on approved plans.
