Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th. instant, in reference to the fees you propose to charge, and the expenses incurred, in connexion with the survey held by you on the machinery of the new S.S. "HANSA" with a view to classification in the Society's Register Book (your first entry report No. 8132), and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the amounts you suggest are considered reasonable for the services rendered, and have been duly noted on the report.

As, however, a further survey is required - which it is anticipated will be carried out at Liverpool in 5 or 6 weeks' time - before the machinery can be accepted for classification, it is considered advisable to defer making application for the fees and expenses until the survey is completed, when the total amount due will be collected on this side, and £16.16.0 (viz; -£10.10.0 fee, and £6.6.0 expenses) credited to your account.
